4. Cell phones, laptops, camera, headphones, and chargers	
5. Contacts, solution, and case	
6. Blow/ hair dryer (one in hotel already)	
7. Curling iron or hair supplies	
8. Deodorant	
9. Glasses/ sunglasses	
10. Jewelry	
11. Make-up

13. Nail polish (preferably none or nude color/ light pink) and remover?	
14. Special pillow/ blanket?	
15. Sunscreen	
16. Water bottles, food, snacks (MUST BE PREPACKGED)

Clothing	Check
1. Business attire (at least one full set)	
2. Business shoes (and black dress socks!)	
3. Comfortable shoes and/or sandals	
4. Sleep wear (robe, slippers)	
5. Casual, DECA appropriate clothing (no holes in jeans, no bare midriffs, etc.)	
6. Swimwear	
7. Underwear (nylons for girls)
